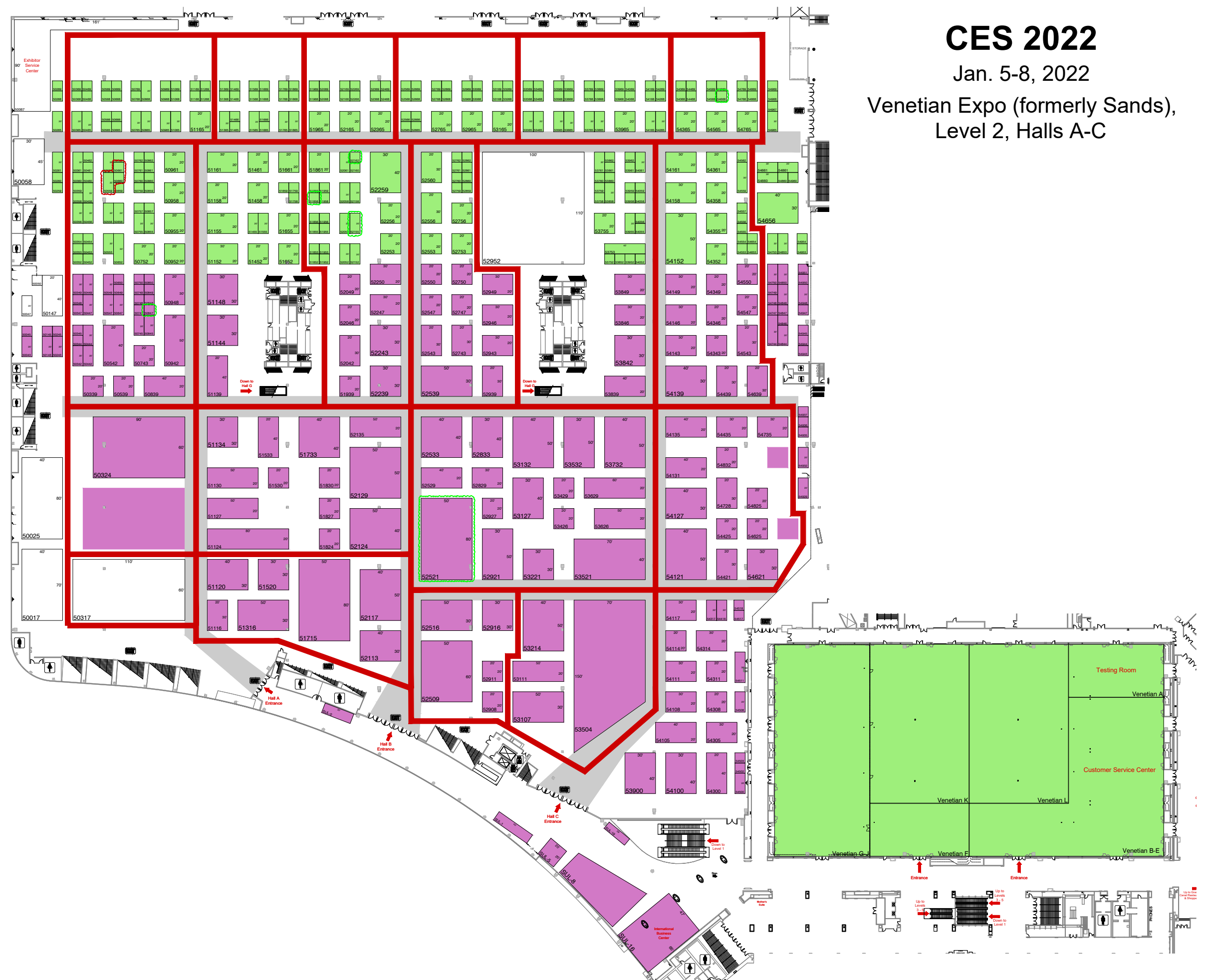

- Empty return will begin at 5 PM on Saturday, Jan. 8. All cardboard and fiber cases will be returned by 11 PM. All crates will be returned by 8 AM on Sunday, Jan. 9.
- All truss must be at working height 6' or below by 10 AM on Monday, Jan. 10. Please place your rigging order accordingly.
- Please find your target freight move-out date and time on this page. This is the deadline for removing your freight from the exhibit floor. You may move out your freight anytime between show break and your target date/time, but everything must be removed by this deadline.
- Complete the following prior to your target freight move-out date and time:
  - Booth packed
  - Shipment labeled
  - Outbound Material Handling Agreement (MHA) submitted to the Freeman Service Center
  - Carrier checked in at the marshalling yard
- Missing your assigned move-out target date and time will result in additional charges being billed back to the exhibitor in the following manner:
  - Any exhibits not packed or left as bulk trash by your assigned target time will either be thrown away or dismantled and packed by Freeman at the exhibitor's expense
  - Any outbound freight whose carrier has not checked in by your assigned target date will either be shipped by the official carrier or held at the Freeman warehouse awaiting further instructions at the exhibitor's expense.
